## **FINAL REPORT**

**Subject: Leslie Purnell Davies**

On Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2007, instructions were received from Daniel Caffrey of KCO Ltd, Dublin, requesting that enquiries be made in Puerto de la Cruz, northern Tenerife to trace the legatees of Leslie Purnell Davies, a Science Fiction writer believed to have died in Tenerife sometime after 1983.

Enquiries at the Puerto de la Cruz Register of Births, Marriages and Deaths were made for the complete period 1982 to-date, however, this met with negative result. Further enquiries suggested that the English Cemetery in Puerto de la Cruz might be worthy of a visit. This cemetery on Calle Dr. Madan is administered by the Anglican Parish of All Saints, Taoro Parque, Puerto de la Cruz. Enquiries at the cemetery and at All Saints revealed that Leslie Purnell Davies died on 6<sup>th</sup> January 1988 aged 73 years and his remains are interred in Niche No 308, the plaque bearing the inscription "In loving memory of my husband". It was further revealed that a Winifred Davies died on 21<sup>st</sup> April 1988 aged 69 years and her remains were interred in Niche No 310, the plaque bearing the inscription "Now reunited with her loving husband". Parish records were checked but no record was found to indicate if there were any relatives living in Tenerife.

Although we have attempted to contact all persons bearing the name "Davies" listed in the local telephone directory, this and all other lines of enquiry with regard to any legatees have met with negative result.

Enquiries have now been terminated pending further instructions.
